*Cost of classes are \$10 per CE credit hour if you pick and choose, or get all 24 hours of CE for \$230.

Each individual who is issued an Ohio resident insurance agent’s license shall complete at least 24 hours of continuing education, including 3 hours of approved ethics training in each license renewal period. You shall apply biennially for a renewal of the license on or before the last day of your birth month. To see the expiration date of your license, go to www.insurance.ohio.gov, then click on “Agents/Agencies – How do I...”, then click on “Agent/Agency Locator”. You can then search for your information by entering your name or your National Producer Number or your Agent’s License number. For best results, enter one of these items, but not all three. Once you reach your license information page by following the above steps, you can now also see your current CE Transcript!!

IMPORTANT: Please check your transcript before scheduling CE classes to ensure that you are NOT REPEATING classes – you cannot get credit for a class taken twice (from the same provider) in the same compliance period.

We enter your CE credit with the state after you attend our classes, HOWEVER, you are responsible for renewing your own producer’s (agent’s) license with the State of Ohio.
